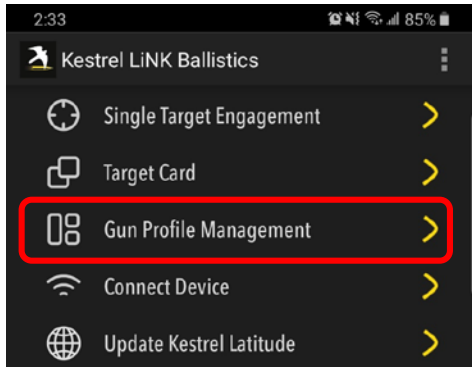




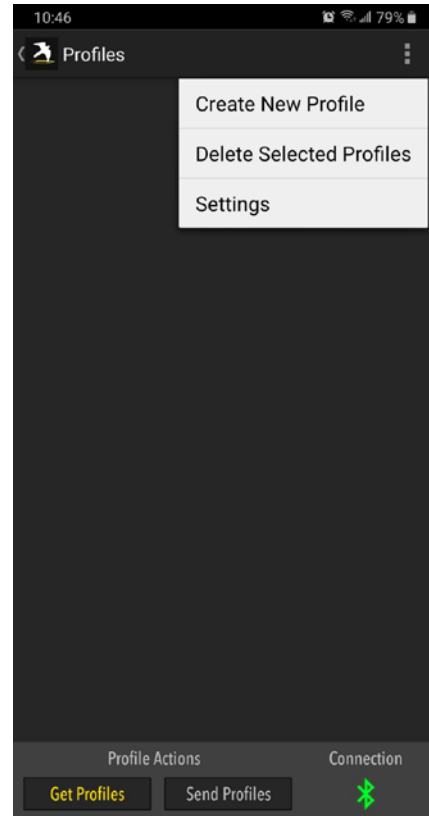
# How to Create and Transfer Bullet Files with Kestrel LiNK Ballistics App



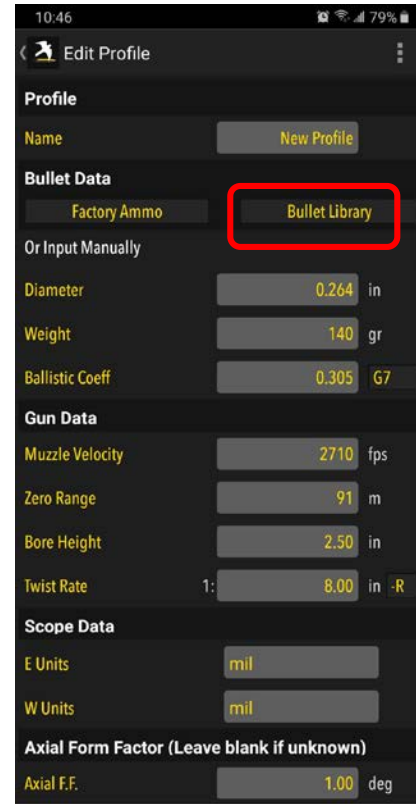
Note: This guide assumes you can already connect with the KLB app, if not, please see [this guidance](#) first.



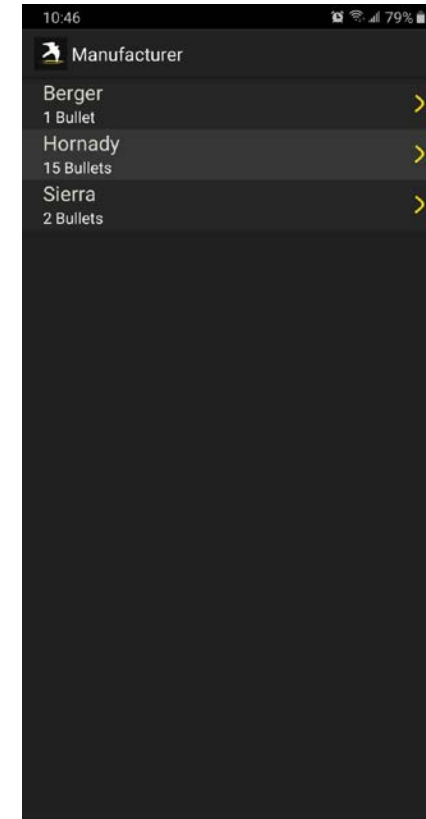
1) Connect to the Kestrel LiNK Ballistics app and select **Gun Profile Management**.



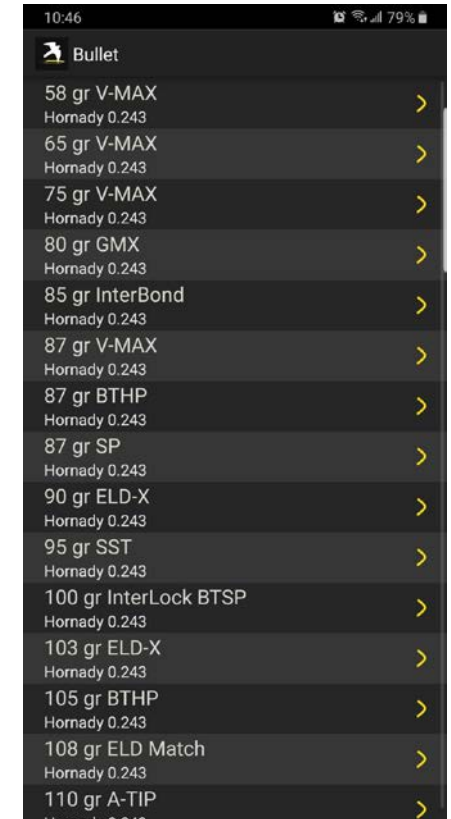
2) Click ellipsis or + sign at the top to create a new profile.



3) Select Bullet Library to view library of bullets available.



4) Choose Bullet Manufacturer.



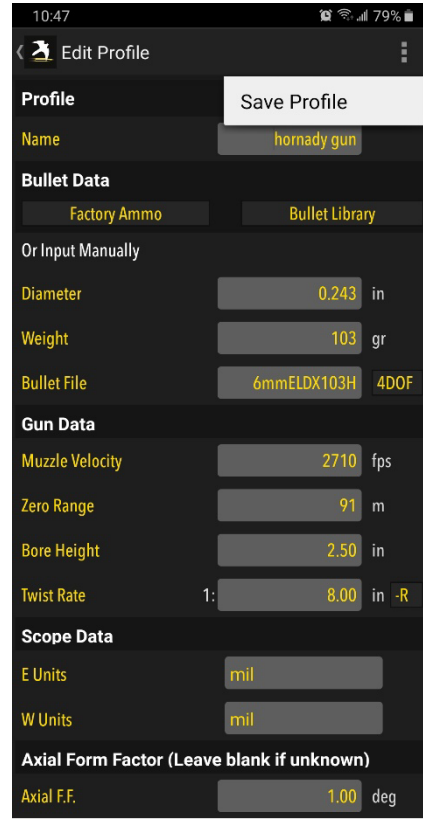
5) Choose bullet size and weight.



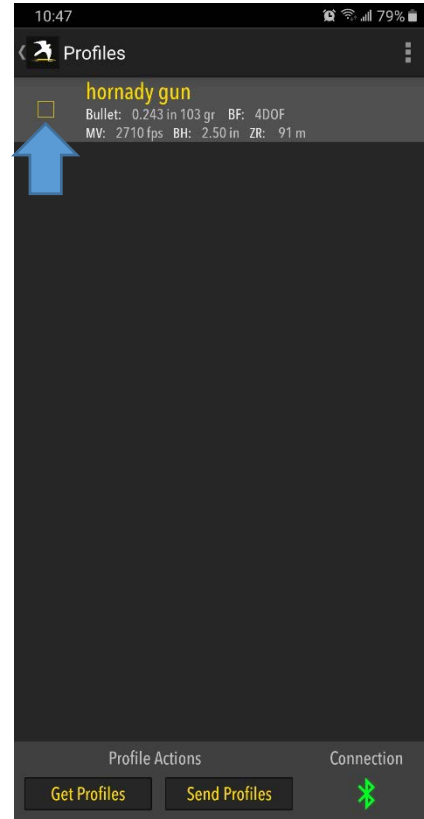
# How to Create and Transfer Bullet Files with Kestrel LiNK Ballistics App



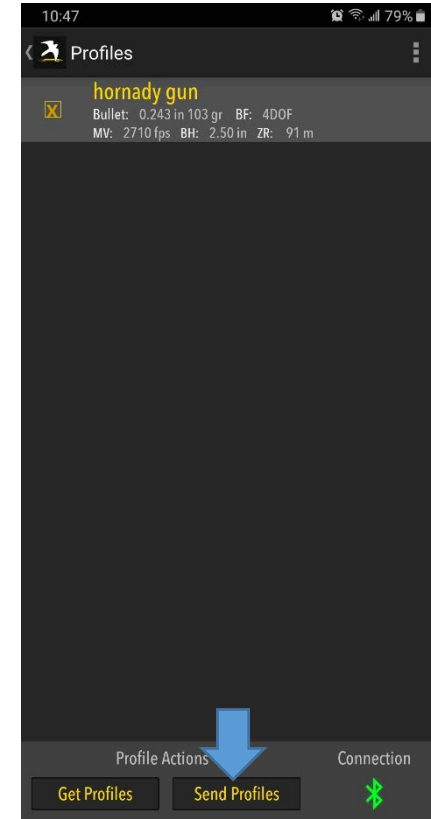
6) Select Solver type.  
Note: 4DOF is not available for all the bullets in library, but would be best option if available.



7) Enter a name and pertinent gun information and click ellipsis to save profile.



8) You must click the radio button next to all profiles you want to send. For iOS, there is a Select button to make radio buttons appear.



9) When all profiles being sent are selected (3 at most), select Send Profiles to send them to a Kestrel. You will have an option to overwrite or append profiles on Kestrel. Get will retrieve all profiles on the Kestrel.
